Where a competitor elects to wear a blue judogi, he/ she must also have a white judogi available to conform with the rules. The women must wear a white non-transparent t-shirt. The bras must not have any hard pieces. Long hair must be tied up with the appropriate elastic band. Make up and jewellery are prohibited. Nails should be cut short The judogi control will be performed by the referees
